

Scholarships for Interdisciplinary Health and Addictions Research Graduate Program

The Centre for Addictions Research of BC (www.carbc.ca) at the University of Victoria (www.uvic.ca) is offering three 1-year entry scholarships for graduates from the health, medical, social and behavioural sciences for a new interdisciplinary health research training programme - the *Social Dimensions of Health Research* (<http://socialsciences.uvic.ca/images/pdfs/SDHRproposal13Mar09.pdf>).

Successful candidates would work under supervision of CARBC faculty to develop advanced research skills in the broad area of the social dimensions of health with specific application to prevention, treatment, policy and epidemiological assessment of substance use and related harms.

Both masters and doctoral level candidates may apply for the scholarships for program entry 1 September, 2010.
